

DETAILS

The Logging Alarm Thermometer allows you to monitor and log sensitive temperatures almost anywhere. Use for storage, transit, refrigerator/freezer, mount on the wall to monitor workplace area, greenhouse, computer room, apartment, HVAC, property management, school, food service, monitor incubators, sample temperature and much more. Select the recording interval that suits you best. Keep yourself informed with a 100 day, 100 hour or 100 minute graphic recording thermometer - that BEEPS when conditions are unfavorable.

Use the Logging Alarm Thermometer™ to Monitor Medical Refrigerator / Freezers

- Choose the 100 hour record function
- View Saturday & Sunday data by the hour for weekend protection!
- Scroll through the data immediately every Monday
- NO PC REQUIRED!
- Write down the temperature values for upcoming JAHCO inspections

For safety, it is important to verify the temperature of the refrigerator. Refrigerators should be set to maintain a temperature between $36^{\circ}F$ and 46° F($2^{\circ}C$ and $8^{\circ}C$). The Logging Alarm Thermometer can be kept in the refrigerator or freezer to monitor the temperature. Choose the model that has a 6FT sensor cable so the Thermometer can sit outside the Refrigerator. This can be critical in the event of a power outage. When the power goes back on, if the refrigerator is still $40^{\circ}F$, the food is safe. Foods held at temperatures above $45^{\circ}F$ for more than 2 hours should not be consumed. Setting the Alarm to ON and the recording interval by the hour will provide valuable information. Be sure refrigerator/freezer doors are closed tightly at all times. Don't open refrigerator/freezer doors more often than necessary and close them as soon as possible.
